Parent/Teacher conferences will be held on Tuesday, November 27th, from 12:30 to 3:30 PM. We will have a half-day of school to allow time to schedule the parent/teacher conferences. School will be dismissed at 11:30 AM and the parent/teacher conferences will begin at 12:30 PM.

Important: You should make an appointment as soon as possible with the teachers you want to see on the 27th. Regular classroom (Homeroom) teachers will have a sign-up sheet for parent appointments at their classroom doors. Individual meetings will be limited to 10 minutes each. The teachers will be available from 12:30 until 3:30 PM.

Special area teachers (Non-Homeroom), including Math, Art, Music, Physical Education, Spanish and Computer Technology have their sign-up sheets in the main office.

All conferences on the 27th are limited to ten minutes. If you have multiple children in school, or need more than ten minutes, or cannot make it on the 27th, please make an individual appointment for another day with the teachers you wish to see. These conferences can be scheduled before or after the 27th, but no later than December 6th.

Next Tuesday, November 20th, the Kindergarten parents and children are invited to attend the annual Kindergarten "Thanksgiving Potluck" at 6:30 PM in the gym. It is always an enjoyable experience.

Thanksgiving is Thursday, November 22nd. School will be closed on Thanksgiving and also on Friday, November 23rd. Please note that Wednesday, the 21st, is a half day with dismissal at 11:30 AM.

On Friday, November 23rd, the American Red Cross will run a Blood Drive all day in the St. Aloysius School Gym. This is an annual event.

St. Aloysius School held a special school assembly on Friday, November 9 in honor of Veterans' Day. The students were treated to a talk by two veterans who are also St. Aloysius Church parishioners.
