The CDA was formed over 100 years ago and today numbers 75,000 dues-paying members in 1,250 courts (local chapters) in 45 states across the country, and in Puerto Rico, Mexico, Guam, and the Virgin Islands.

Members of St. Aloysius Court #744 seek an increased awareness of their Christian obligations through a wide variety of functions and activities. Among their many activities they make baptismal bibs, sponsor an art/poetry contest, fund and award a high school and college scholarship, do fundraising for St. Agnes Home for Unwed Mothers, bake and sell Irish soda bread every March, and host the dessert table every June at our St. Aloysius Patron's Feast.

Our regular meetings for members are held on the 1<sup>st</sup> Thursday of every Month at 7:30pm from September to June.

Membership in the Catholic Daughters of the Americas organization is possible for women 18+, girls 6 to 17, and ladies attending college.
