CATECHIST INFORMATION

Every 4th grader in St. Aloysius Religious Education completes the Saint Witness project. The 4th grade Religious Education curriculum focuses on our call to live as disciples of Jesus; by our witness to speak and act upon what we know and believe about Jesus ... just like the Saints! As part of Confirmation Preparation, in 8th grade all Confirmation Candidates will select and research a Saint and take that Saint's name as their Confirmation name. We hope this 4th grade Saint Witness project will start our students thinking about the Communion of Saints as a precursor to Confirmation.

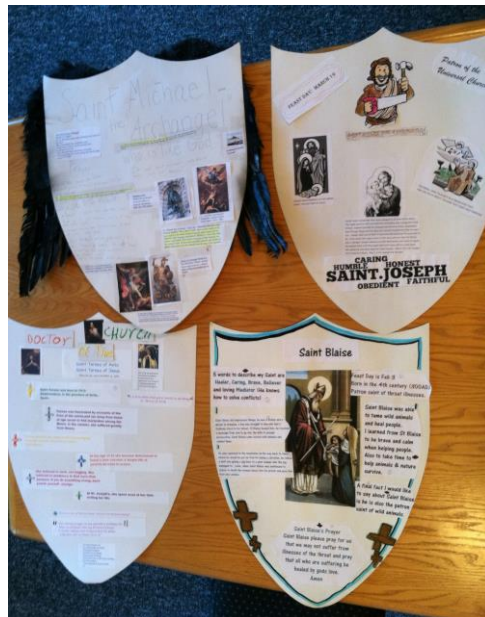
Each student should tell their catechist 3 things:

1. Which Saint your child is to study (need the name)
2. What form of presentation you would like to do, either;
a) dress up at All Saints 5:30pm Mass **or** b) poster shield presentation to the class,
3. Finally, if any child is dressing as a Saint at the Mass and would like to be a Lector or Gift Bearer at the Mass, they must be dressed as a Saint to do this.

The “project/presentation” should be **ONE** of the following:

1. Oral Presentation with Poster Shield **or**

In class – date to be selected by Catechist and student



2. Dress Up for All Saints Liturgy 5:30pm daily Mass on Thursday, November 1, 2018:

WITH THE NAMES OF THE STUDENTS WHO WISH TO DRESS UP AND
PARTICIPATE IN THE LITURGY!



The RE office will make a hanging sign with the name of the saint each student has chosen in advance.
RE must have the name by Friday, October 26, 2018.

When and where do the children arrive for the Mass on Wednesday?

5:15pm in the church Narthex in costume or if borrowing from RE they will receive the costume at that time

Does the RE provide the costuming?

If requested, the Re office has some costumes please notify us by Friday, October 26th if you need a costume.

Each student should write the following information about their saint on an index card that they can refer to when one of the clergy should ask them a question about their saint during the Homily.

The *Who, What, When, Where and Why*” of the Saint –

- **Saint Feast Day _???**
- **Patron Saint of _???**
- **Impressive thing about this Saint or Life Lesson that I learned from the Saint or Quotable Quote that the Saint said – basically why are they so Saintly ...**

- A. All the “Saints” will process in with the priests and sit together in reserved pews in the front; they will be called up during the homily and then return to their seats and process out with the priests at the end of Mass.
- B. If dressing up to participate in the All Saints Liturgy, the student does not need to do a poster shield.
- C. RE will have extra costumes at Mass in the narthex in case a “saint” doesn’t show and another 4th grader present (and willing) at the Mass can take their place.
